Science

In this topic we will learn about the different food groups and how they make up a balanced diet.

We will learn about the skeleton and muscles, be able to name the different parts of the skeleton and muscles and explain why they are important. We will then identify and group animals with and without skeletons.

Finally we will be looking at human and animal teeth and have a visit from a dentist.

Computing

We will be looking at the work of the artist Georgia O Keefe and using pastels and pencils to create our own flowers. As part of our English work about Fantastic Mr Fox we will be also study the illustrator Quentin Blake and illustrate our Mr Fox stories.

English

We will be reading Fantastic Mr Fox by Roald Dahl and writing our own sequel to the book. We will then be researching and writing non chronological reports about human and animal teeth.

The year will end with Paddington Week when we look at the work of the author Michael Bond and enjoy his tales about the bear from Peru.

We will continue to learn spelling words from curriculum spelling list.

PE & Games

In this topic we will continue to swim every week and prepare to take part in the Year 3 swimming gala. We will also be taking part in athletics ready for Sports Day.

Maths

We will be practising our recall and use of multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables. We will also be revising the four operations addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Later in the term we will be measuring, comparing, adding and subtracting mass (kg/g) and capacity (ml/l).
