WHAT IS THE WAVERLEY ABBEY CHALLENGE?

The Waverley Abbey Challenge is open to all Year Six pupils and is uniquely designed to develop skills for life and preparation for the next stage of education.

Achieving the award isn't a competition: it's all about setting personal challenges and pushing personal boundaries.



WHAT IS THE WAVERLEY ABBEY CHALLENGE?

Through participating in the Waverley Abbey Challenge, the children will have fun, make new friends, improve their self-esteem and build confidence. They will gain essential skills and attributes for secondary school and beyond such as resilience, problem-solving, team-working, communication and drive.

THE 5 ELEMENTS



Physical Activity

Community

Life Skills

Expedition

Environmental Awareness

PHYSICAL ACTIVITY

1

Complete 30 hours of physical activity and sport.

2

This can include any clubs you already attend, both in and out of school.

3

Record in your booklet and an adult (parent, carer, coach, club leader) signs it off .

ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS

Two separate challenges

1) British Flora- Create a tree identification poster or booklet. Use photos, collage, rubbings, computing skills- whatever you like!

2) British Fauna- RSPB Big Bird Watch

EXPEDITION

Plan and complete a 10 mile family walk.

You can, with your adults permission, complete this with your friends and their families.

COMMUNITY

Complete 15 hours of community service.

You can contribute to your local area and gain new skills.

You can complete this at a place of your choice.

Examples: Rainbows, National Trust, individual tasks such as baking a cake for a neighbour, odd jobs for family,

LIFE SKILLS

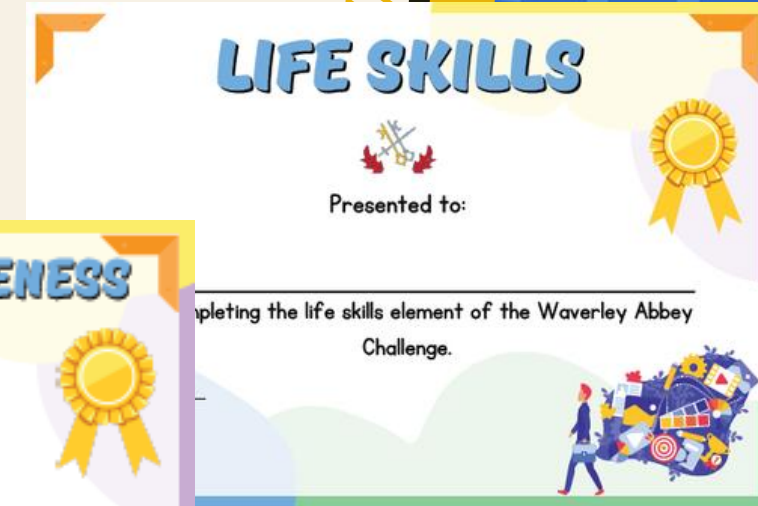
Complete a list of important life skills throughout the year and get an adult at home to sign them off.

Examples-Making a meal, basic sewing skills, making a bed, ironing, using the washing machine, making a phone call, basic hygiene.

Presentation skills- Plan and deliver a 2-3 minute presentation to a panel. You can choose your own topic!

WHAT DO I DO WHEN I COMPLETE AN ELEMENT?

When you complete an element, bring your booklet to Mrs Wade to be signed off. You will then receive a certificate for each completed element. There are 5 to collect! You need to make sure you organise your time to meet the deadlines.
