




- Reading book

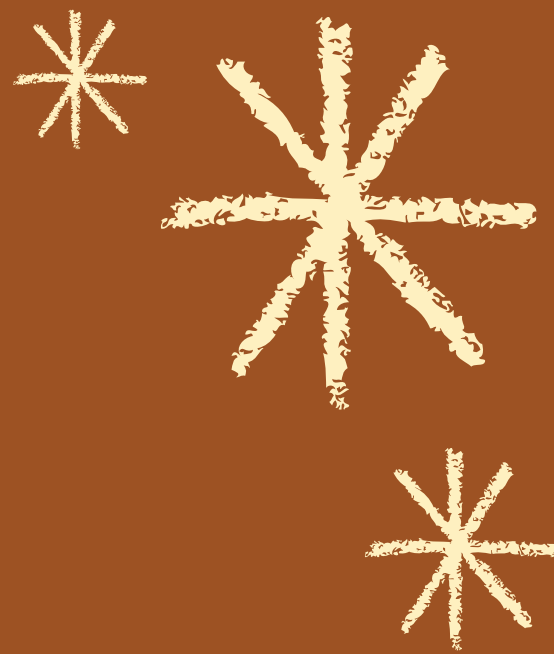
