HEADTEACHER'S UPDATE

Next week's worship theme – Making good choices

We have had another busy week in school. It has been lovely walking through lessons seeing the children so actively engaged. It has been a pleasure seeing so many children with excellent writing in their books too. Last week, we also completed the selection of our pupil voice groups. I am always impressed with the level of preparation that pupils put into their speeches, letters of application and interviews. It is always a very hard decision for staff and pupils. Well done to every pupil who applied for a role. Whether they were successful on this occasion or not, they should feel very proud of their efforts.

Leave of Absence: A reminder to all parents/carers about term time leave of absence.

A pupil's absence during term time can seriously disrupt their continuity of learning. Not only does the child miss the teaching provided on the days they are absent, they are also less prepared for the lessons after they return. There is a consequent risk of underachievement, which the school and the parents/carers should seek to avoid.

Parents/carers are strongly advised against booking any leave of absence during term time as they will not be authorised. School holiday dates are published a year in advance and are available on the school and Surrey County Council websites.

Penalty Notices - Penalty Notices will be issued by the Local Authority for unauthorised leave of absence in term time.

Mobile phones: We actively encourage families not to allow their children to bring expensive items into school including mobile phones. However, if your child must bring a phone in then our school policy is that they need to drop it off at the office first thing in the morning, returning to pick it up at the end of the day. We should also have a letter/ E mail confirming that your child will be bringing a phone onto the premises. Thank you for your co-operation in this.

Waverley DSL Team: At Waverley we have a number of staff who make up our DSL (Designated Safeguarding Lead) team. Ms Morris is the lead with myself, Mrs Munro, Mrs Hilyard, Mr Brown, Miss Haines and Mrs Parker Swann (HSLW) too. If you have a concern, however small, we always ensure that there is a member of the DSL team on site if you want to come and talk. Leave of Absence/Penalty Notice Information From Surrey Inculsion

Just to remind parents/carers that if they take their children out of school without authority for 5 or more days (which do not have to be consecutive), then the following will apply:

- If you have not incurred a penalty notice relating to this child/children in a rolling 3 year period since 19 August 2024, then the penalty notice will be charged at the rate of £160.00, per parent/carer per child, if paid within 28 days. This will be reduced to £80.00 if paid within 21 days of receipt of the notice. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.
- 2. If you have incurred a penalty notice relating to this child/children since 19 August 2024, the rolling 3 year period will be activated from the date of the first penalty notice and the second penalty notice will be charged at the flat rate of £160.00, per parent/carer per child, if paid within 28 days. There will be no reduction for payment within 21 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.
 - 3. If you have incurred 2 penalty notices relating to this child/children in the rolling 3 year period since the first penalty notice was issued, then you will NOT receive a third penalty notice Surrey County Council will have no option but to consider a prosecution, per parent/carer per child, in the Magistrates Court under s 444 Education Act 1996.

Please make sure a Leave of Absence Form (available on the school website or from Reception) is completed.
