The choir's next event is 'Carols On The Green' on Sunday 30th November in Tilford (4pm). I have heard that there will also be a brass band accompaniment which I know the children are very excited about. Do save the date!

Thank you to all who attended our Waverley Abbey fireworks night, once again it was a resounding success. We have also raised over £1000 for the school too which is wonderful! FOWA have a tight turnaround and are already thinking ahead to our Christmas Fair next month. Next Friday (28.11), and the following Friday (5.12) are non-uniform days to provide gifts for FOWA to sell on the day. For those families new to us, on each non uniform day we ask that parents give a small gift (no more than £3 in value) which you would be happy to receive if it were given to you. This enables children the opportunity to buy presents for their grown-ups at the Christmas fair in secret, wrapping the gift at school. The children absolutely love doing their 'Christmas shopping' with their friends in school and it has become a real Waverley tradition over the years.

Christmas Post Boxes: The school Christmas post boxes will be out on Monday 1st December. If your child would like to send cards, the post boxes will be in the shared year group space. Please ensure that your child writes both the recipient's surname and class otherwise we have trouble directing them to the right person!

Save the Children Christmas jumper day: On Monday 15th December the children may wear a Christmas jumper to school in return for a £1.00 donation to Save the Children. This is also our Christmas lunch day. Where possible, we encourage families to reuse and recycle Christmas jumpers. We would also love to see plain jumpers that have been decorated at home too!

PAPAYA - Save The Date!

At the end of July, our current Year 6 pupils had a brilliant workshop with Papaya, which focussed around the theme of forming a healthy balance with technology (Parents Against Phone Addiction in Young Adolescents - https://www.papayaparents.com/). Together with the children, the staff from Papaya looked at how we can understand both the advantages and disadvantages with our increasing reliance on digital devices.

As part of their commitment to our school, PAPAYA will be hosting a parent workshop too for all of our school families which will be online on Tuesday 9th December at 7pm (see flyer attached for link)

Papaya talks and workshops empower parents and young people to make informed choices about smartphones, social media and screens.

The expert-led sessions offer insights and practical advice about the benefits of delaying smartphone and social media use and the importance of establishing healthy tech boundaries in families.

The session is non-judgmental, open for honest discussion, and for adults only.

Parking and Collection
