


When pollen for one plant fertilises a second plant to produce seeds

How Water Moves through a Plant

- The roots absorb water from thesoil.
- The stem transports water to the leaves.
- Water evaporates from the leaves.
- This evaporation causes more water to be sucked up the stem.

The water is sucked up the stem like water being sucked up through a straw.
