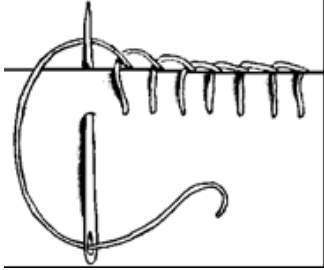


Year 4 Design and Technology: Textiles – lunch bags
