Welcome to the second newsletter of the autumn term. After the first few weeks of the new school year, which are always about settling in and setting the standard for the year, we are now fully immersed into school life. The school holidays seem but a distant memory!

This week we have been focused on Harvest and remembering what's important. Our children are so fortunate, so it is lovely to see them giving back so willingly and supporting our local community. I hope that most of you have been able to see the Facebook pictures of our collection for the Farnham food bank – the response from our families has been overwhelming – thank you. Donations have been picked up this week and will be used by local families. This week we also received the wonderful news that the water bottles and school equipment that we sent in the summer term has reached our link school - Thundu, in Malawi. The children were seen in photos and videos queuing up for their stationery and water bottles - they looked so excited! I have no doubt that this will make a difference to their learning. Miss Bedford and the Global Schools team will post further photos next week but a huge thanks to the team for organising the delivery and to all our families who contributed.

Drop off/ pick up: As we know this is often a 'pinch point' as we have so many cars on site. One of the biggest factors in slowing down traffic is when cars

leave site and wish to turn right, towards
Tilford village. Once again, if I could politely ask that
as many parents as possible turn left, and loop
around (see map overleaf), our queues would undoubtedly be shorter.

Nut free school: Please remember when packing children's lunchboxes that we are a nut free school. We do have children with severe nut allergies and therefore cannot have any nuts or nut products (peanut butter etc) on site.

Labelling uniform: There have already been a large number of jumpers and other school uniform left on playgrounds/ the field after break and lunchtimes. When the clothing is clearly labelled with the child's full name this is easy to return, however there have been items with no name at all or just initials. As I'm sure you can appreciate, with nearly 500 children it is essential that clothing is clearly named for a quick return. Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

Pick up collection: Please remember to put in the home contact book if your child is going home with a friend or someone other than the main contact listed on our system. We have had a few incidents this week where we have had to phone families to confirm playdates etc. Thank you.

IMPORTANT - Lost Property

Please make sure ALL items of clothing are clearly marked with your child's <u>full name</u>, these items will then make their way back to the owner. Everything else will be disposed of at regular intervals as we do not have space to store it all. Each year group will have their own lost property collection point where children can look for missing items.
