Leave of Absence – A reminder to all parents/ carers about term time leave of absence:

Not only does the child miss the teaching provided on the days they are absent, they are also less prepared for the lessons after they return. There is a consequent risk of underachievement, which the school and the parents/carers should seek to avoid.

Parents/carers are advised against booking any leave of absence during term time as they will not be authorised. (except for exceptional or medical reasons). School holiday dates are published a year in advance and are available on the school and Surrey County Council websites.

All absences of 10 days or more will be reported to the Local Authority and the Educational Welfare Officer. Penalty Notices may be issued by the Local Authority for unauthorised leave of absence in term time.

Mobile phones: We actively encourage families not to allow their children to bring expensive items into school including mobile phones. However, If your child must bring a phone in then our school policy is that they need to drop it off at the office first thing in the morning, returning to pick it up at the end of the day. We should also have a letter/ E mail confirming that your child will be bringing a phone onto the premises. Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

Drop off/ pick up: A reminder that we are asking all families (wherever possible) to turn left out of school at the beginning and end of the day to improve the traffic flow and reduce the queue times. Thank you for your co-operation in this.

We have also had a few children left on school site before 8.20 am. Please do not leave children unattended until our staff come on duty at 8.20 am. If dropping off is a challenge there is an on-site breakfast club provided by SCL which does have some spaces. Please enquire in the office if you would like your child to attend this club.

Could we also please remind families not to let their children climb or swing on our beautiful trees. Tree climbing is most definitely an out of school activity!
