The last two weeks certainly have been busy at Waverley! Last week we took a keen group of Year 5 and 6 pupils to the Surrey County Championships, and they faired very well, ending up in the middle of the championship table. No mean feat considering the number of Surrey schools there are. Well done all!

Last week the school celebrated World Book
Day in style. We started the day with the great
Waverley book swap – thank you for your
support in this. The children thoroughly enjoyed
being able to choose a book and take it home.
We also judged the children's wonderful
bookmark pegs. Our wonderful winners were
Maya in Year 6 and Anaiya in Year 4. FOWA
were instrumental in designing the competition
and giving the winners prizes. We are very
grateful for their continuing support.

This week I have visited all classes to look at English. I have been very pleased with the progress in all classes and the rich vocabulary that children are confidently using verbally and in their books. I have also looked at reading records alongside Mrs Hilyard. Please continue to read with your children and hear them read too – this remains vital and should not stop when children leave KS1. In lower school all children have a reading record which parents

should write in to mark when they've heard their child read. We love to see this at least 3 times a week, ideally 4.

STEM week: Our STEM (Science, technology, engineering, and maths) this week has been a huge success. At the start of the week all children had the opportunity to explore the world of virtual reality, looking at either animals or minibeasts. The interactive workshops were very informative and were a real insight into nature! We were also fortunate to have an outside speaker in every day to talk about their STEM careers. Many thanks to those who shared their experiences with the children. The subject matter was absolutely fascinating - it has given many of our young people the opportunity to consider a variety of career paths.

Learning Support Assistant role: Next term, we are looking to recruit a learning support assistant to join our team. The job is term time and can be part or full time.
