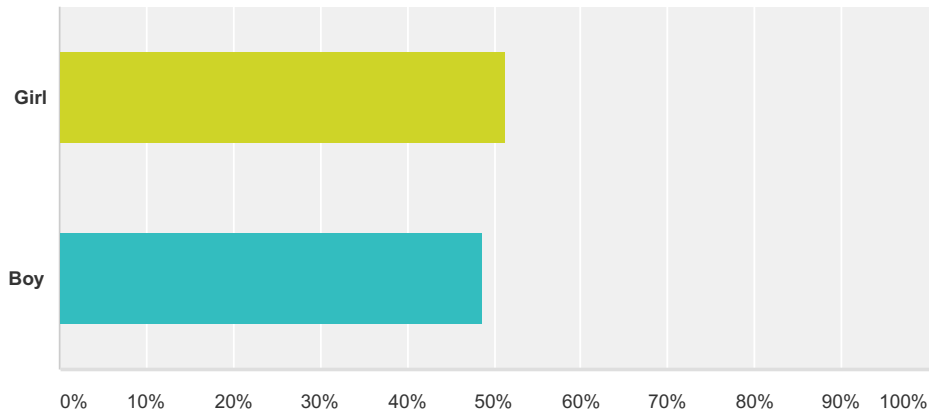

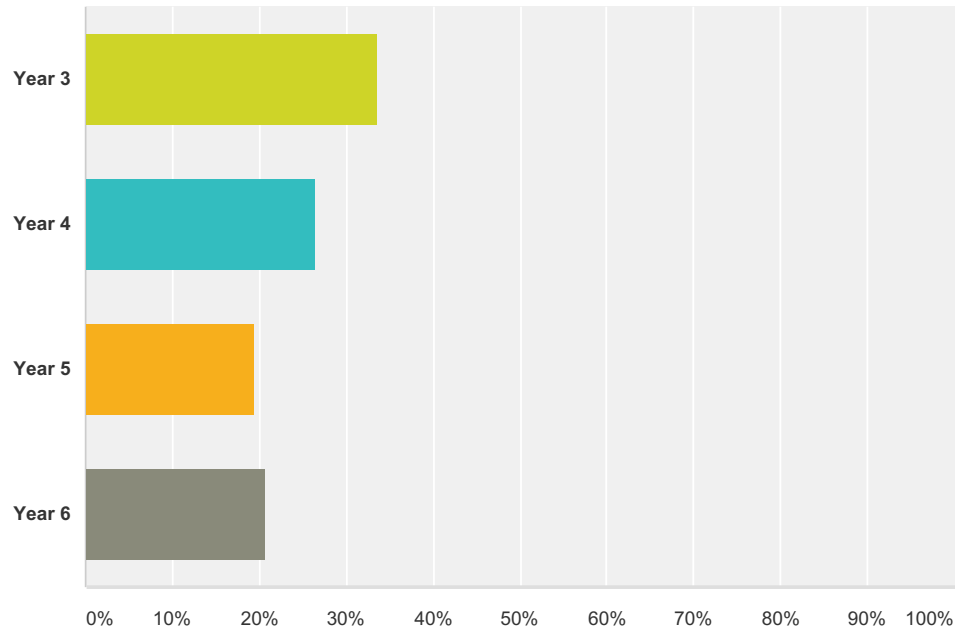

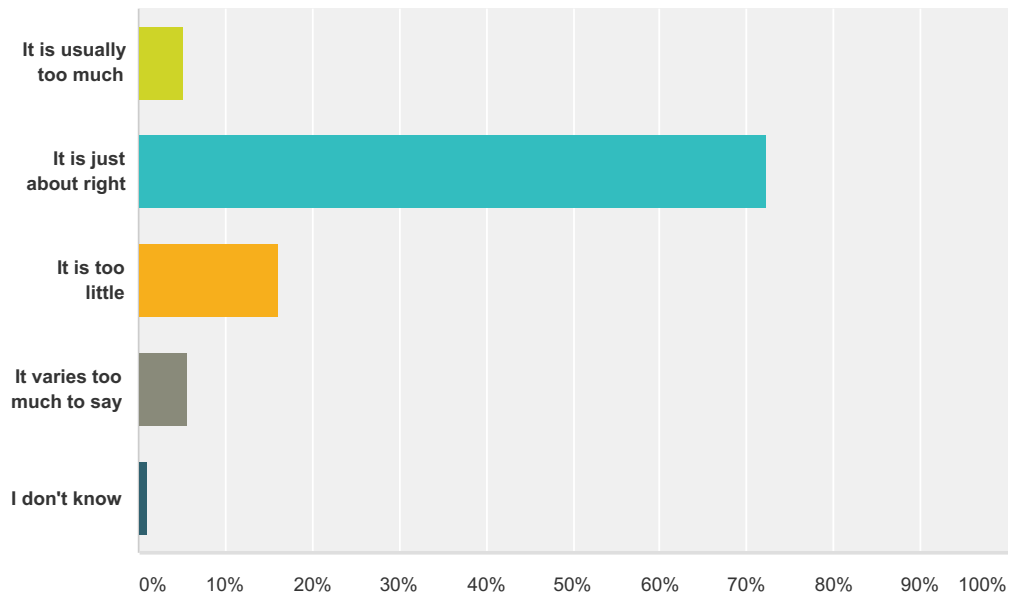

Q3 What do you think about the amount of homework your child gets?

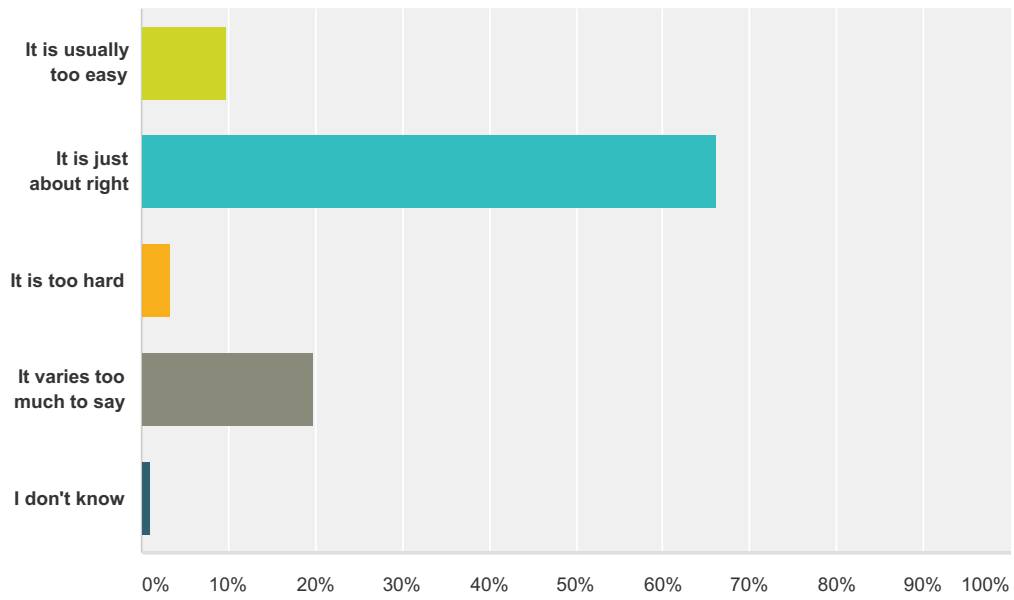

Q4 How difficult does your child usually find his/her homework?

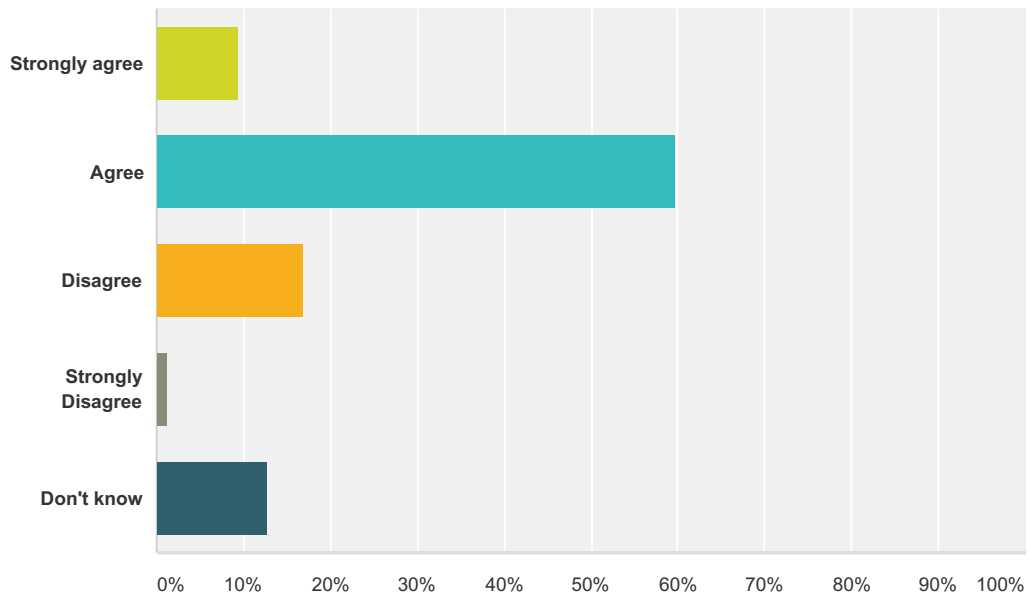

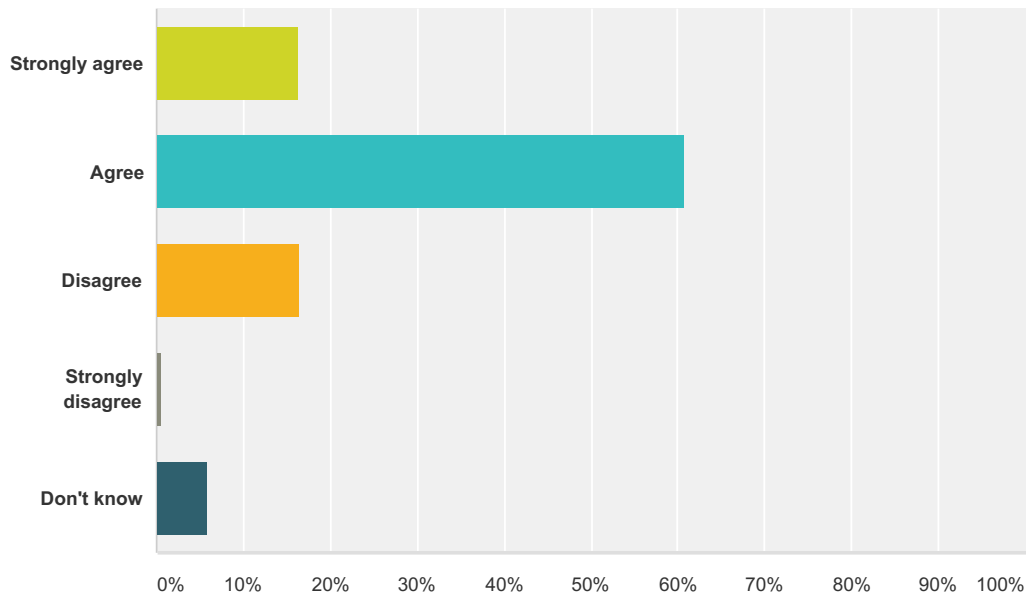

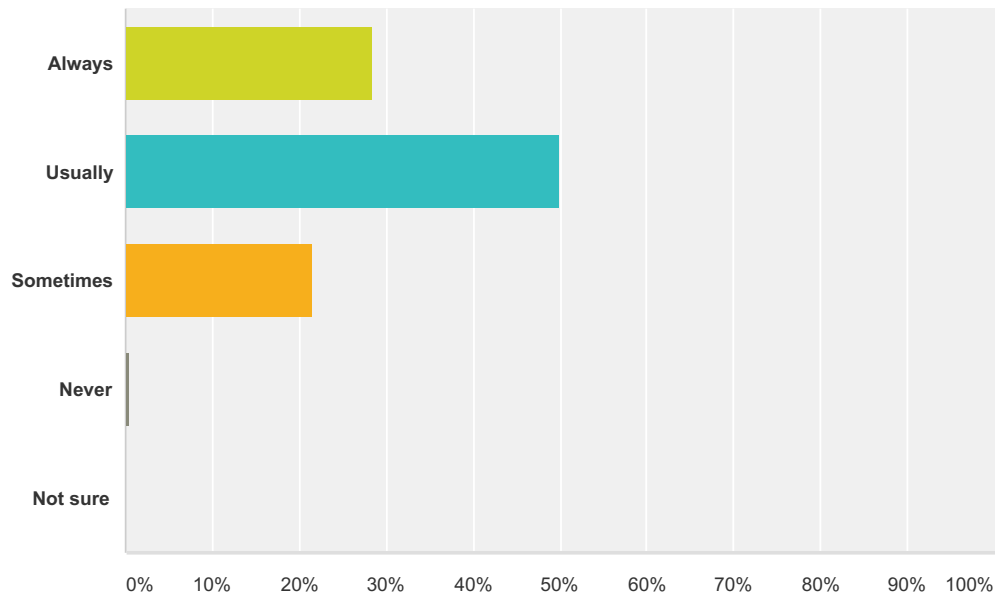

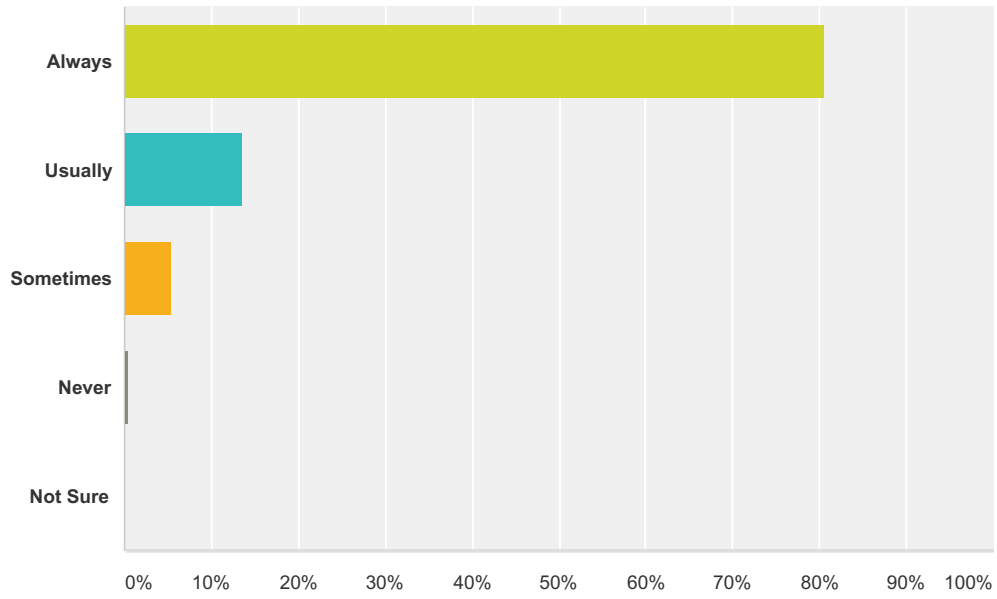

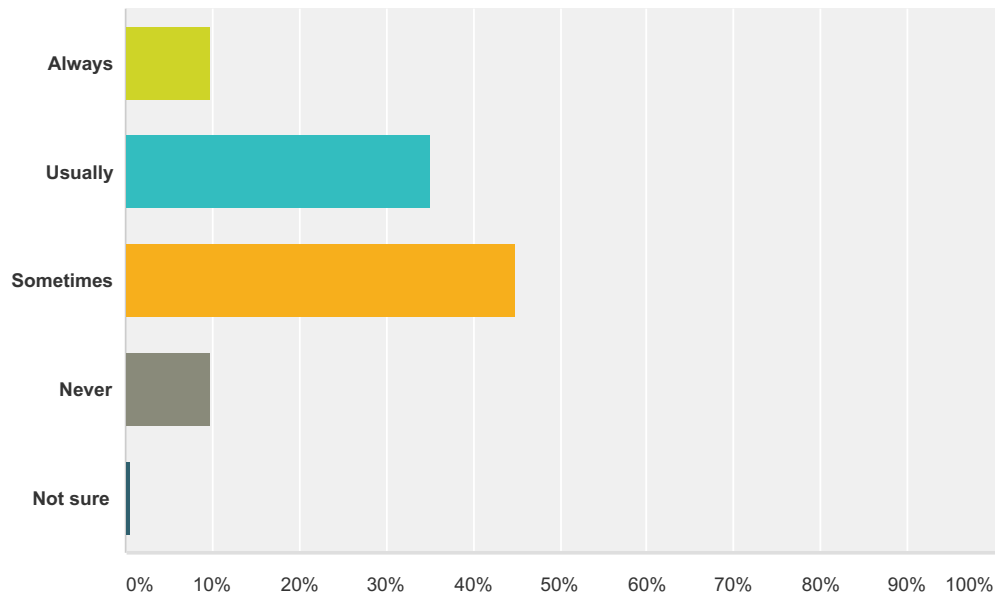

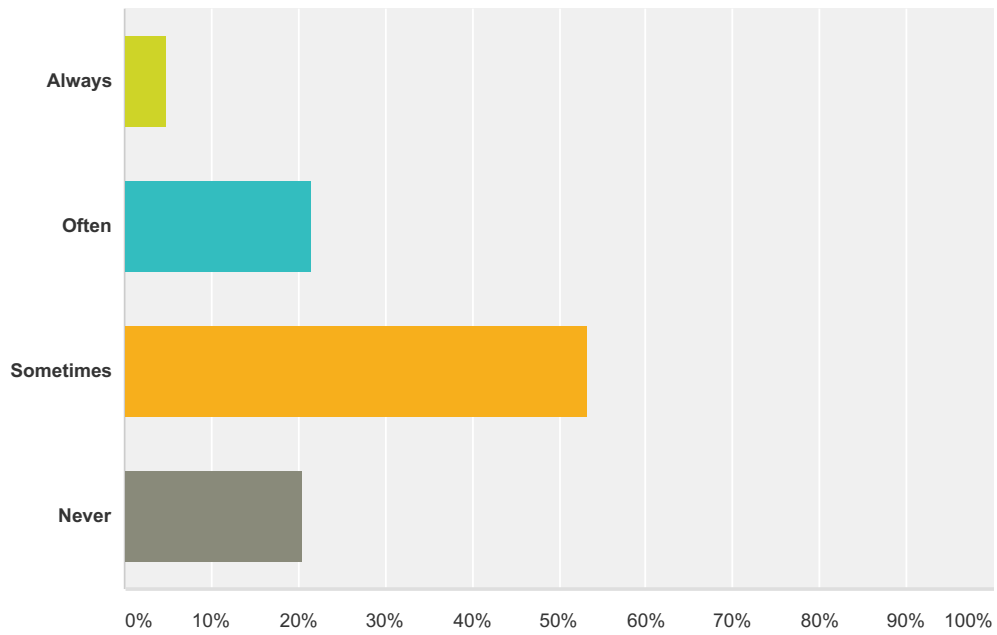

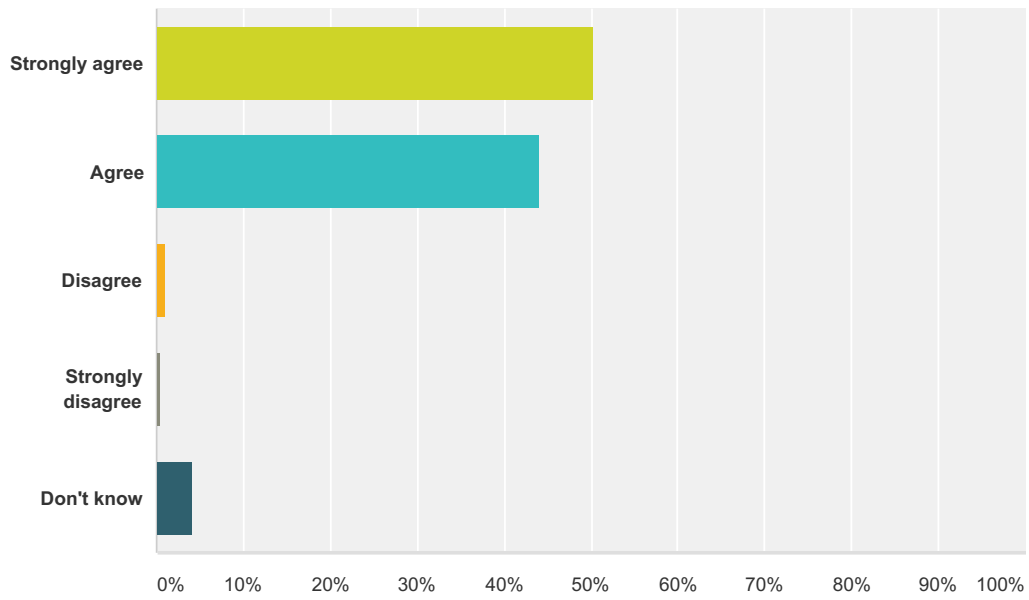

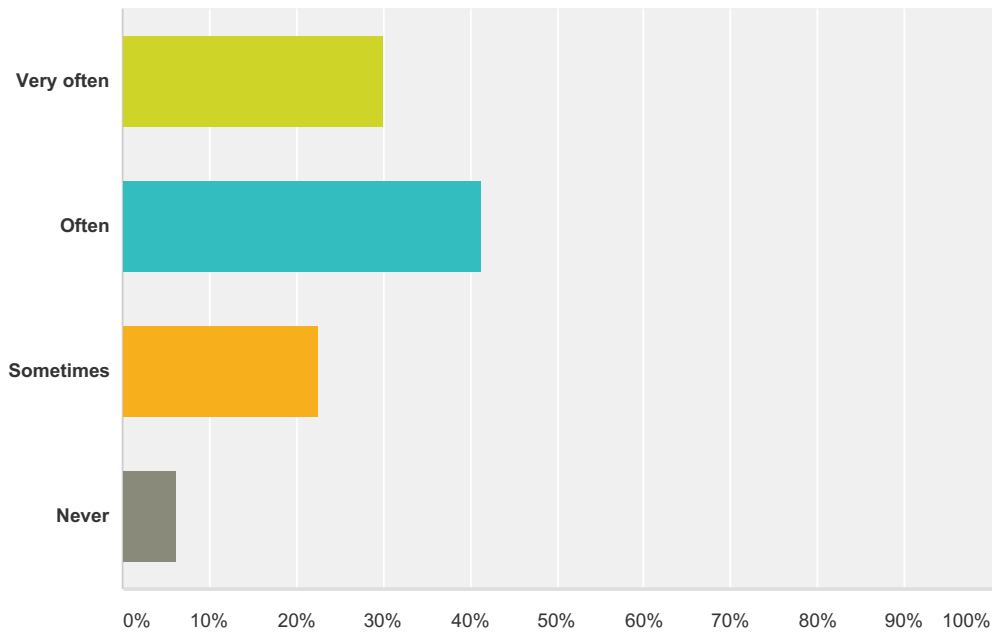

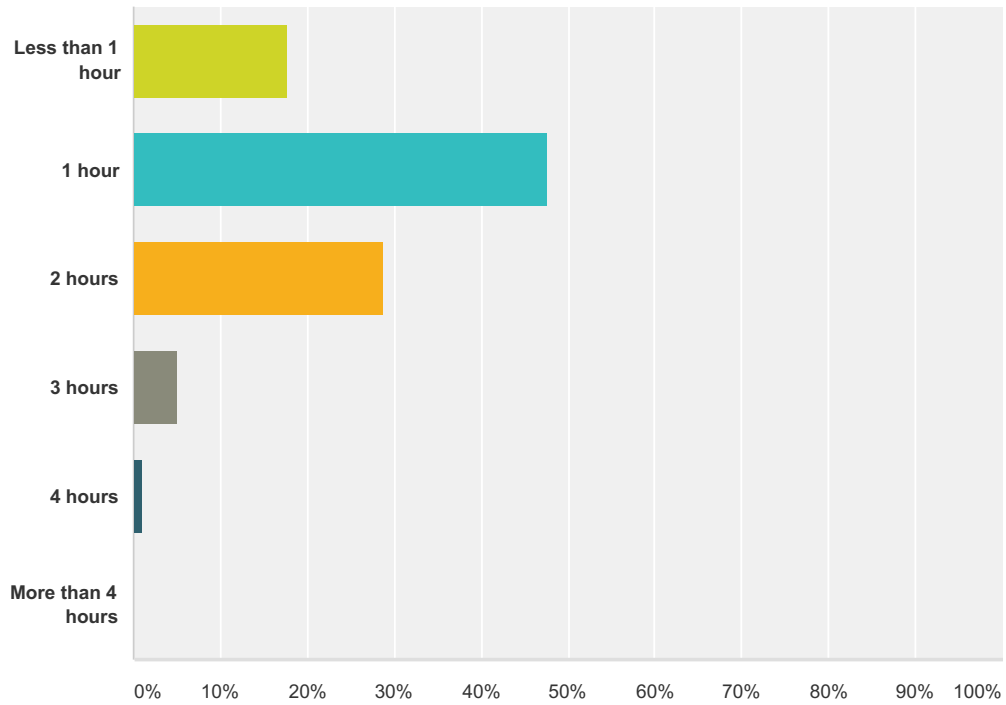

Q13 How much homework do you think is appropriate per week?

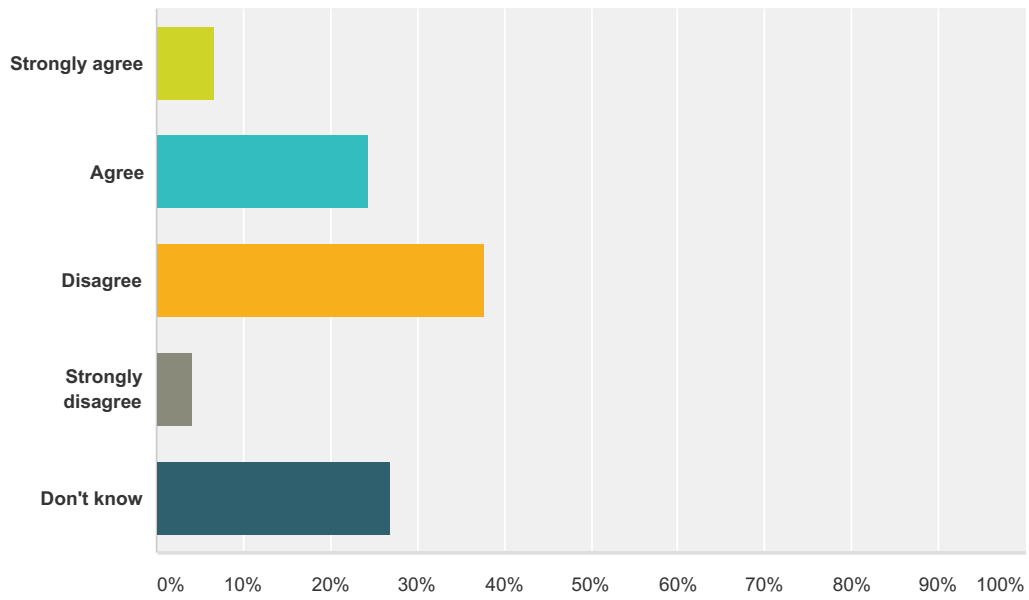

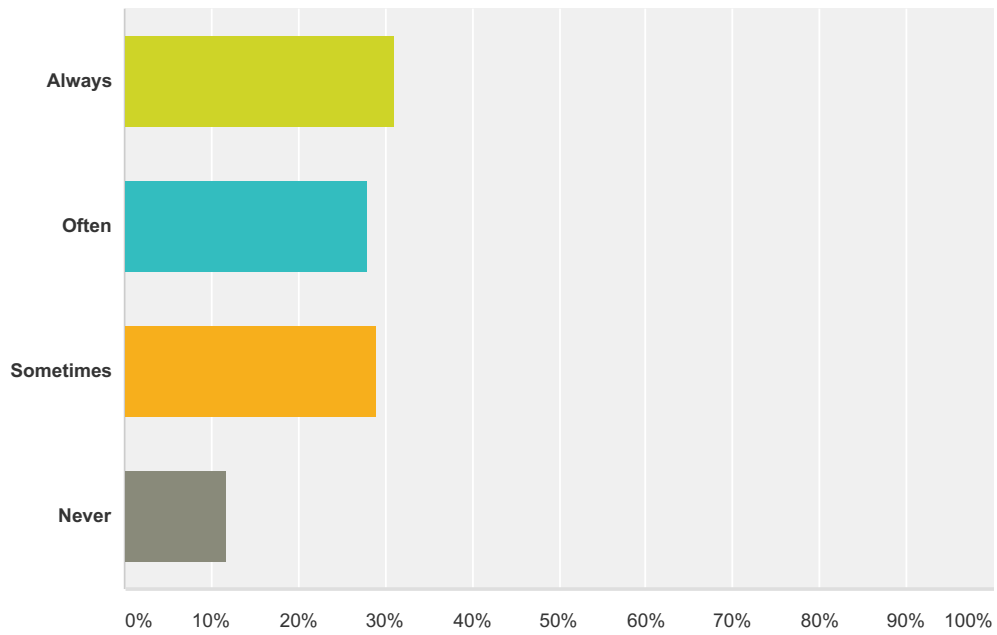

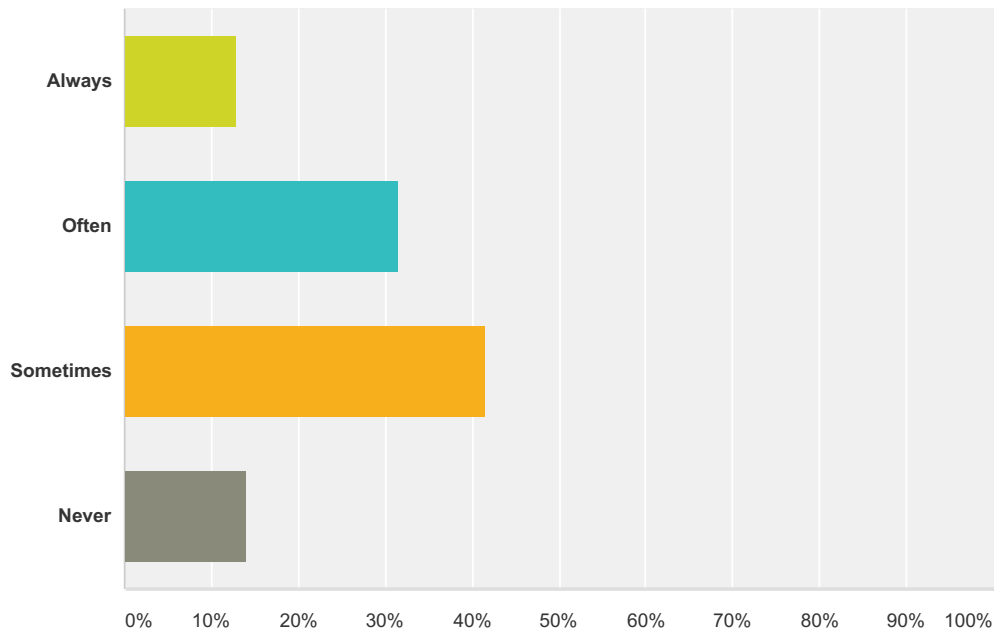

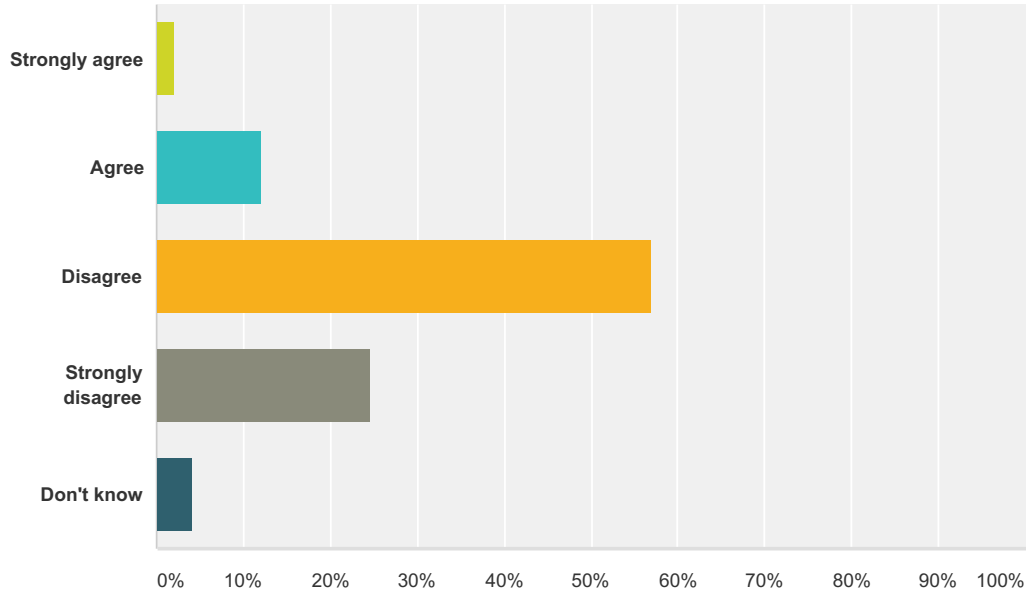

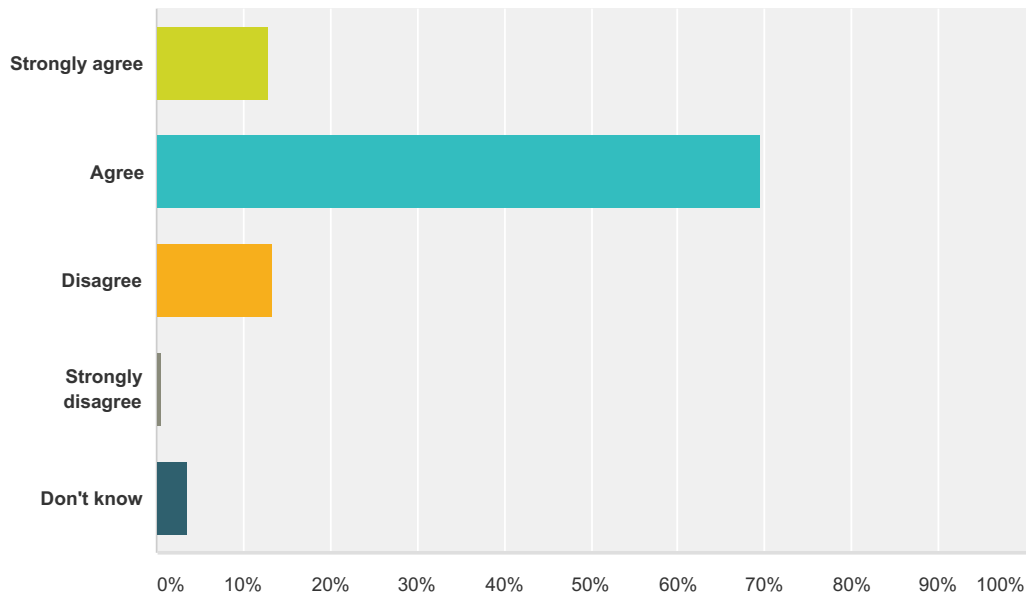

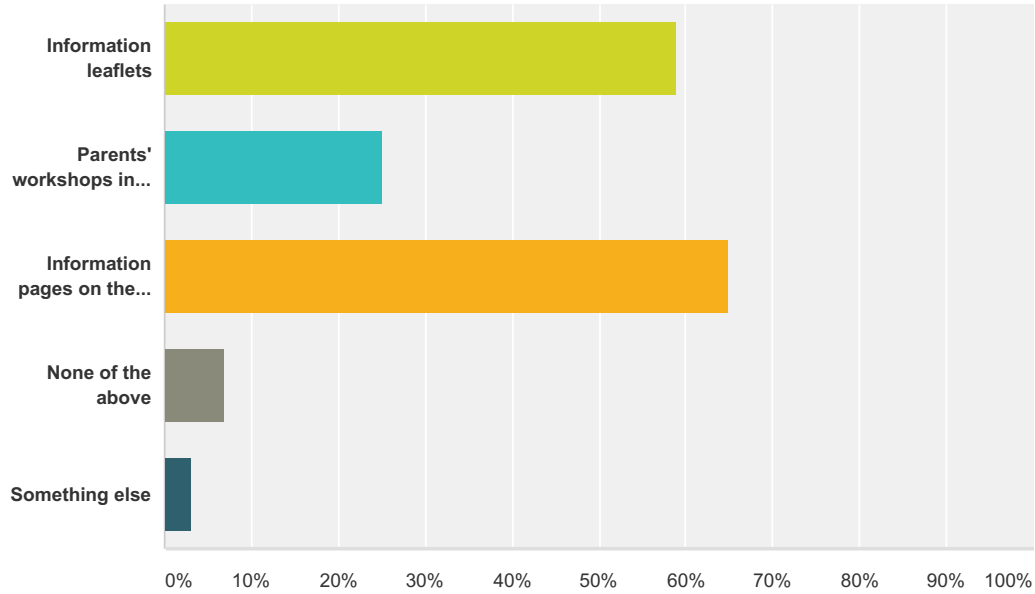

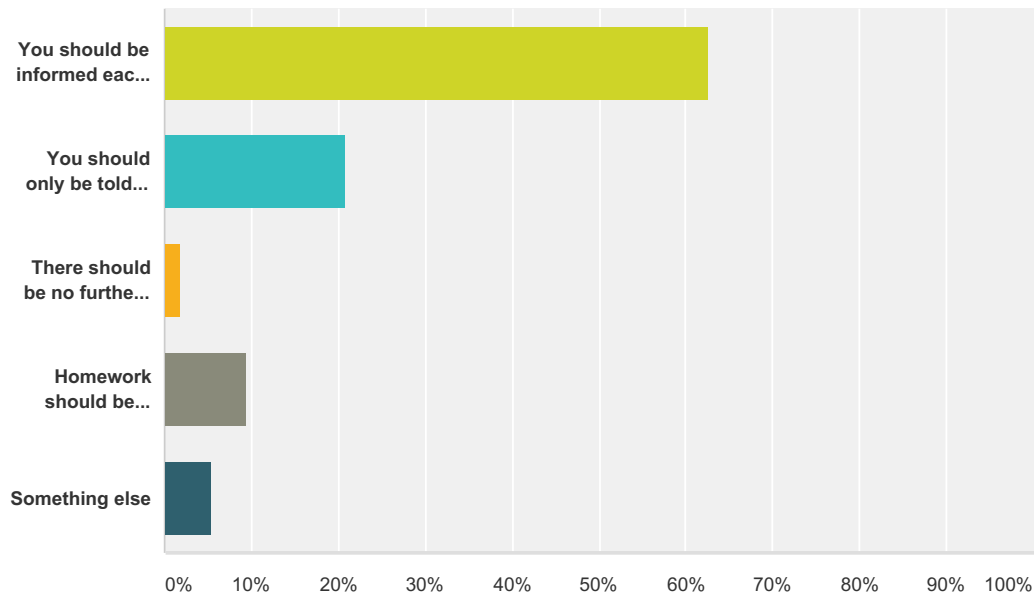
