Unit Vocabulary –

print making	the art of creating an image or pattern by transferring ink or paint from on surface (block or sheet) to a canvas
mono printing	This is technique where you roll ink out onto a surface, then blot cover in paper and draw onto. The ink transfers on to the paper.
block printing	Creating a print from a block which has a pattern carved into it.
collagraph	is as versatile printing process in which a textured plate is inked up ad press on using a brayer
brayer	These are used to roll ink out ready for printing.
etching	Carving lines and shapes into a surface
pattern	
mono printing	Drawing patterns directly onto an inked surface and laying a blank sheet/canvas on top to pick up the design
impressed	The raised area on a printing block
Relief printing	when you carve into a printing block that you then use to press onto paper and make a print.
layer	Any additional print done on top of a printed pattern
relief	where ink is applied to the original surface of the matrix.
Printing block	A block used in printing, with a pattern carved into it.
Printing ink	A coloured liquid used for printing.
