Welcome back to the first newsletter of the new school year. We have had a fantastic start to term - the children have been such a delight and have all settled back in very well indeed.

A huge thank you to all those parents who were able to attend (and Year 5 who are attending tonight) this week's 'meet the teacher' meetings. It has been wonderful to welcome parents into school and for families to see their child's classroom. For parents who were unable to come, all presentations have been put onto the school website for your perusal.

Polite reminder – car parking: We wish to start the year as we mean to go on in terms of children's arrival and departure! One of the biggest factors in slowing down traffic on the main road, is when cars leave site and wish to turn right, towards Tilford village. Whilst I have no authority to enforce a left turn only policy, if as many parents as possible would be willing to turn left, and loop around (see map overleaf), our queues would undoubtedly be shorter. We also ask that parents arrive no more than 5 minutes prior to picking children up. We operate a staggered end of day and if our younger children's parents arrive too early, then there is nowhere for Y6/5 parents to park which leads to long queues on the road. Please note we have opened the field gates so that parking can be there as well, so please feel free to use this resource too.

Children are welcome onto the Year 6 playground from 8.20am. Prior to this there is no adult on duty. Please ensure that any children remain in cars or supervised on the paths until a member of the senior leadership team

Uniform: Thank you for ensuring that your children have returned wearing the correct uniform. I have never seen shirts tucked in so quickly! If a child forgets one day, we will keep them safe in the office for you to pick up at the end of the day.

Local committee members meet half termly to look at the school's development and this is an exciting opportunity to be part of the strategic team. If you are interested in applying, please enquire at the office for a form.


#### **WAVES Refunds**


Well done to Felix in Year 3, who has just been awarded his blue belt in Karate. Super effort Felix!
