### **Pupils achieving the expected standard 2018**

<b>Writing</b>	80%	78%	+2
<b>Mathematics</b>	88%	76%	+12

<b>Spelling and Grammar</b>	92%	78%	+14
<b>Combined R/W and M</b>	76%	64%	+12

### **Pupils achieving the higher standard compared to the national 2018:**

<b>Subject</b>	<b>School</b>	<b>National</b>	<b>Difference</b>
<b>Reading</b>	54%	28%	+26
<b>Writing</b>	12%	20%	-8
<b>Mathematics</b>	37%	24%	+13
<b>Spelling and Grammar</b>	52%	34%	+18
<b>Combined R/W and M</b>	5%	10%	-5

**OFSTED statement for junior schools** - We know from national data that pupils at junior schools, on average, have higher attainment scores at the end of key stage 2 than pupils at all other primary schools. However, they also have lower progress scores. It is not clear what causes this but inspectors should be aware of this when using and interpreting data for different school types.
